

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TURNER ARTS INITIATIVE

The Turner Arts Initiative aims to provide constructive and uplifting activities for at-risk youth, offering a counter balance to negative influences that can impact young people. This year, we were thrilled to reintroduce our talent show in a live format, hosted at Shady Oak Brewery in Santa Rosa called So You Think Sonoma County's Got Talent with the Stars! The show featured 15 auditions, from which 7 acts were selected to perform. Participants showcased a diverse range of talents, including dance, comedy, singing, theater, and more. We took great pride in our 3 finalists. Looking ahead, we are eager to revive our Turner Arts summer camps and after-school programs in 2025.



Scholarships

Each year, the Turner Arts Initiative selects a deserving individual for our Music and Performing Arts Scholarship. This year, we were thrilled to recognize Teryn Trent as our honoree. Teryn holds a special place in our hearts as he was the inaugural recipient back in 2016 during his high school years. His dedication, coupled with the support of our partner, the New World Ballet Center, enabled him to make remarkable strides academically, leading him to excel at the esteemed Butler



University. Having recently graduated from the university, Teryn is now gracing stages across the nation with his dancing talents. We proudly awarded him our \$1,500 scholarship to aid in his continued advancement in the performing arts field.



Additionally, thanks to the generosity of an anonymous donor, we were able to extend our appreciation to the New World Ballet Center by presenting them with a \$2,500 scholarship. This gesture honors their ongoing commitment to empowering at-risk and underserved youth in our community through the transformative power of dance and performing arts.





NEXTGEN TRADES ACADEMY



The NextGen Trades Academy caters to underserved youth aged 16-24 in the North Bay region, offering a multi-week program covering vocational construction training and essential life skills. With over 24

construction trades included, such as architecture, plumbing, and electrical work, participants also receive instruction in resume writing, financial literacy, real estate and job interview preparation and more.

The curriculum integrates various teaching methods, including technology and hands-on experience, aiming to seamlessly transition graduates into desired careers within the trades. Collaboration with 208 local contractors facilitates program development, guest speakers, interview opportunities, and job placement assistance. Additionally, specialized courses in electrification, sustainability, and renewable energy reflect the academy's commitment to preparing graduates for industry demands. Despite Covid-19 delays, all six cohorts were conducted as hybrid courses, with online classes during the week and in-person sessions on Saturdays.

Program Implementation:

Amid prolonged Covid-19 delays, all six cohorts were conducted as hybrid courses, blending online classes during the week with two in-person sessions on Saturdays. Despite these obstacles, our services reached 98 participants across Sonoma, Marin, Napa, and Solano counties, with the majority hailing from low-income households, reflecting diverse backgrounds. Additionally, in 2023, our ongoing partnership with the Sonoma County Juvenile Probation Department facilitated the successful graduation of 9 youth, emphasizing our dedication to offering educational opportunities to those facing justice system challenges. Among the graduates, 73% are employed, 3% are in custody, and 24% are actively seeking employment.

Furthermore, our program expanded into Marin County for its inaugural private cohort, serving at-risk Marin youth with the support of 5 new partners below. We are currently in the process of securing rewarding careers for these graduates in sustainable building techniques and renewables, continuing our mission to empower and uplift youth across different communities.






















Program Statistics as of 2023

- 81% of work-eligible students were placed in full-time work after graduating.
- 92% of students showed significant improvements in their self-reported attitude toward career choices, skill level in the trades, ability to cope with stress, and clarity about what they want in life.
- 51 graduates completed their 10-hour Osha Safety Certifications.
- 503 students served since implementation in 2017.
- 12% of students served were identified as female.
- 89% of students served were low to moderate income.



2024 PLANS

- To resume in-person classes in the Spring.
- To expand program to additional high schools in Sonoma and Marin County.
- To expand program to Solano, Napa, Mendocino and Bay Area Counties.
- To conduct the vocational training for Affordable housing in the North Bay.
- To implement Virtual Reality training for high earning careers such as Electrical, Carpentry and HVAC.
- To finalize the curriculum and development of the Nextgen Auto Academy.
